## GARBAGE & RECYCLING INFORMATION – 2020

### Garbage Pickup

Garbage pickup in New Holstein is every Thursday beginning at 5:00AM, or on Friday's if a holiday falls during that week. For new service, broken container or to change your container call New Holstein City Hall at 920-898-5766. **If you are requesting a garbage container size change there is a \$20 charge.**

## City of New Holstein Waste and Recycling Cart Guide

- Place all recyclable material into your cart. There is no need to separate paper from glass, aluminum, plastic or tin.
- DO NOT place ANY plastic bags in your recycling cart
- Do not place trash in your recycling cart
- All recyclables must fit inside your cart with the lid closed. Place your recycling cart with the front of the lid facing the street and the wheels of the cart towards your house.
- Place your recycling cart 4ft away from obstructions such as mailboxes, utility poles, trees and cars.
- Keep your recycling cart 4 ft away from your garbage can. The best solution is to put your garbage can and recycling cart on opposite sides of the driveway.
- Cart cannot be placed on top of snow banks, they must be ground level.
- Make sure you place your cart at the curb by 5am the day of pick up or the night before. Please remove your cart 24 hours after collection.
- Reminder- Yard waste is NOT allowed in either garbage cans or recycling carts.

## Curbside Recycling Guide

Place recyclables loosely in your bin. **No plastic bags!**

### Plastic

#### ACCEPT:

ALL plastic bottles & containers

- Household bottles, jars & jugs
- Dairy containers & lids
- Produce, bakery & deli containers & lids

#### DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Plastic bags, wrap or film
- Motor oil bottles
- Styrofoam



*empty, rinse & replace caps/lids*

### Paper

#### ACCEPT:

- Newspapers & inserts
- Cardboard & paperboard (food boxes)
- Milk, juice & soup cartons
- Office & school paper
- Junk mail & catalogs
- Phonebooks, books & magazines

#### DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Tissue paper
- Pet food bags

*flatten & cut boxes to  
2 ft x 2 ft*

*put shredded paper in a  
paperbag*



### Metal

#### ACCEPT:

- Aluminum bottles & cans
- Steel & tin cans
- Empty aerosol cans

#### DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Aluminum pans or foil
- Empty paint cans
- Scrap metal



*empty & rinse*

### Glass

#### ACCEPT:

- Food and beverage bottles & jars

#### DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Window glass
- Ceramics, china
- Drinking glasses

*empty & rinse*
